LAST YEAR ACTIVITIES - 2021-2022

1. Working Result :-

The Trust during the year, under report has bagged a net surplus to the tune of Rs. 2110/- which has been, utilized for acquiring of assets and social works.

2. Social Works :-

The Trust during the year has continued its various social welfare Activities of which every year we have done. They are as follows:

a) Help to Poor :-

The trust during the year distributed clothes and blankets among the very poor people in our project area. Near about 21 families were benefited of this programme. The local panchayat Pradhan and other renewed person were also present of this glorious activities. The trust spent an amount Rs. 2180/- for these activities.

b) Aged Welfare :-

As per last year activities we organized 05 (Five) Health Awareness camp with covering 04 (Four) villagers for awareness creation among the aged people of rural areas. We also distributed some medicines among the poor people though out the year. Our medical team and our office staff also help them for their actual need. In future we would be able to provide Mobile Medicare services with the local people. The trust expended for carry out its Health Activities among the aged welfare. The trust spent an amount Rs. 2946/- for these activities.

c) **Educational programme :-**

The rural children students are suffering from lack of proper guidance. In order to remove this impasse, the trust opened a tutorial home to guide and teaches the local students. The trust opened Nursery types school of SC/ST and backward students for upliftment of education. We have also distributed the study materials e.g. book, exercise books, school uniforms, pen, pencil, geometry boxes etc. among the students of our target area. The trust expended Rs. 2340/- for this purposes.

d) **Rural Road Repairing :-**

As per every activity the trust also repaired 0.2 Km. rural Kancha Road at rural remote area. The village rode is important part in village life of the rural people. The total communication system and economical background is spouse of this village road. The trust and local people of that are both undertake of this work jointly. The local panchayat members also helped us for implementation of this works smoothly. We hope in the coming year will be able to do more and more works in the works in the sector. The Trust spent an amount of Rs. 1540/- for this programme.

e) **Plantation :-**

During the year trust decided that near about 150 numbers trees will be planted both side of village main road and others waste land area. These trees are Akashbani, Sabadul, Sirish, Mehagani, Neem, Mahuya and coconut tree. All the members of the trust participate to plant the various types of tree. We able to understand the significance of the plant living man and animals take oxygen grow the tress that give us other raw materials. The common people are also interest towards the plantation. The afforestation also helps us to protest to pollution. The Governing Body of our trust sanctions an amount for the activities. The panchayat and people are help with the trust to conduct this work properly. The Trust expended Rs. 4700/- for this programme.

f) **Training Programme :-**

As per last year activities the trust training programme on Yoga & Naturopathy mainly among the poor women and youths in our locality. The participants are taken training progrmme for their need. The trust decided to distribute the loan from financial institution for conduct the business to earn the money. The trust sanctioned an amount Rs.4780/- for this programme.

g) **Environmental Programme :-**

The world a forestation day was celebrated by the society with full dignity. All the members or our society participated in Plantation programme or the various types of tree.

We were able to make aware the people about the significance of the plants as life lime of earth. The plants provide not only Oxygen for human being and animals the tree give us another Raw materials. The common people were also motivated for the plantation. Out members aware able to teach the people that the Plantation is necessary for making the pollution free environmental. An amount of Rs. 3290/- for this programme.

h) **HIV/AIDS Camp :-**

From the past years the trust is taking extra ordinary measures for prevention of HIV/AIDS. Through, in our country HIV/ AIDS appeared much later than in other parts of the worlds but it is gradually tightening its grip. This killer disfeature is spreading rapidly and has now emerged as serious social, economic and public health problem. While offering curative care to AIDS patients seems to be distant reality in the absence of a vaccine, the only and one evolving, strategies to prevent and central the unabated spread of this disease is 'Awareness Building Measures'. The Trusts taking all necessary measures for

preventing of AIDS under his experienced hands. The Programme was a great success. The trust sanctioned an amount of Rs. 7218/- for this purposes.

i) **Relief Mass Programme :-**

The trust during the year conducted the Relief Mass Programme for the people of the flood affected people. The local panchayat members and youths are help and co-operation with our trust to distribute the Relief foods, cloths, and Medicine etc. Near about 57 families were benefited of this programme. As per appeal by these floods effected people we the trust decided that to set up crèches centre and free tutorial home to provide these children/students who are flood effected of that area. The trust sanctioned an amount for this noble programme.

j) **Camp, Workshop and Training Programme :-**

The trust organized many types of camp, workshop and seminar programme in the different places of our project area. These programm are Environmental Camp, Road Safety Off Smoking, Yoga & Naturopathy, General Awareness etc. These activities are very needful on our area the local resources person and administration are help with us for proper implement these programme. The local people and other person are much more benefited of this programme. The executive committee has been sanctioned an amount Rs. 20547/- for this activities.

The Governing Body of our trust sanctioned an amount of Rs. 8140/- for these activities.

b) Educational Programme :-

Our trust got most successful result in this programme. Four mistress teachers basis formula about one hundred twenty eight students, common people encourage and help us according to their desert.

The trust apart a coaching centre for promotion of elementary education for children of which is very much necessary. The said coaching centre is very popular among the poor rural people. They are happy for participation of the activities. The executive committee has sanctioned an amount Rs. 890/- for this programme.

LAST YEAR ACTIVITIES - 2019-2020

1. Working Result :-

The Trust during the year, under report has bagged a net surplus to the tune of Rs. 470/- which has been, utilized for acquiring of assets and social works.

2. Social Works :-

The Trust during the year has continued its various social welfare Activities of which every year we have done. They are as follows:

a) Help to Poor People :-

The trust during the year distributed clothes and blankets among the very poor people in our project area. Near about 18 families were benefited of this programme. b) Aged Welfare :-

As per last year activities we organized 02 (Two) Health Awareness camp with covering 01 (One) villagers for awareness creation among the aged people of rural areas. We also distributed some medicines among the poor people though out the year. Our medical team and our office staff also help them for their actual need. In future we would be able to provide Mobile Medicare services with the local people. The trust expended for carry out its Health Activities among the aged welfare. The trust spent an amount Rs. 788/- for these activities.

c) **Educational programme :-**

The rural children students are suffering from lack of proper guidance. In order to remove this impasse, the trust opened a tutorial home to guide and teaches the local students. The trust opened Nursery type's school of SC/ST and backward students for upliftment of education. We have also distributed the study materials e.g. book, exercise books, school uniforms, pen, pencil, geometry boxes etc. among the students of our target area. The trust expended Rs. 8140/- for this purposes.

d) **Rural Road Repairing :-**

As per every activity the trust also repaired 1.2 Km. rural Kancha Road at rural remote area. The village rode is important part in village life of the rural people. The total communication system and economical background is spouse of this village road. The trust and local people of that are both undertake of this work jointly. The local panchayat members also helped us for implementation of this works smoothly. We hope in the coming year will be able to do more and more works in the works in the sector. The Trust spent an amount of Rs. 2330/- for this programme.

e) **Plantation :-**

During the year trust decided that near about 680 numbers trees will be planted both side of village main road and others waste land area. These trees are Akashbani, Sabadul, Sirish, Mehagani, Neem, Mahuya and coconut tree. All the members of the trust participate to plant the various types of tree. We able to understand the significance of the plant living man and animals take oxygen grow the tresses that give us other raw materials. The common people are also interest towards the plantation. The forestation also helps us to protest to pollution. The Governing Body of our trust sanctions an amount for the activities. The panchayat and people are help with the trust to conduct this work properly. The Trust expended Rs. 10220/- for this programme.

f) **Training Programme :-**

As per last year activities the trust training programme on knitting & Tailoring, Bee-keeping, Vocational Training and Artisan Training mainly among the poor women and youths in our locality. The participants are taken training progrmme for their need. The trust decided to distribute the loan from financial institution for conduct the business to earn the money..

g) **Environmental Programme :-**

The Trust during the year has incurred expenses of Rs. 1600/- for the purchase of different types of trees. They are names as JHAU, UCALIPTUS, MEGHAGANI, NEEM, SIRISH and other fruit trees. The trust planted these trees on both side of village kancha roads and irrigation cannels with the help of local panchayet and villagers. So many villagers of the area have been participated in this programme and they protected the trees willingly. Also the trust has conduct 02 Nos. environmental camp in our local area for awareness creation among the people of our society. The resource Persons and local Panchayet members also present in this camps

h) **Infrastructural Development Programme :-**

The Trust during the year purchased the Assets. The assets are purchased worth Rs. 400/- they are Clock & Books and Sports Goods.

i) **Relief Mass Programme :-**

The trust during the year conducted the Relief Mass Programme for the people of the flood affected people. The local panchayat members and youths are help and co-operation with our trust to distribute the Relief foods, cloths, and Medicine etc. Near about 142 families were benefited of this programme. As per appeal by these floods effected people we the trust decided that to set up crèches centre and free tutorial home to provide these children/students who are flood effected of that area. The trust sanctioned an amount Rs. 11400/- for this noble programme.

j) **Camp, Workshop and Seminar :-**

The trust organized many types of camp, workshop and seminar programme in the different places of our project area. These programm are Environmental Camp, Road Safety, Off Smoking, Yoga & Naturopathy, HIV/AIDS Camp, General Awareness. These activities are very needful on our area the local resources person and administration are help with us for proper implement these programme. The local people and other person are much more benefited of this programme. The executive committee has been sanctioned an amount Rs. 9561/- for this activities.

k) **Cloth Distribution for Child :-**

The trust has been distributed cloths among the poor and needy student/ children. During the year we distributed cloths; 17 Nos. beneficiaries. The local people and administration co-operation with us for implement the programme properly. The trust has been sanctioned an amount for this purpose.

l) **Gift / Toys Distribution for Children :-**

During this year the trust distributed the Gift/Toys for children in our locality. There are 75 Nos. of children are benefited about this programme. The executive committee has been sanctioned an amount for this purpose.

m) **Games & Sports :-**

During the year the trust arranged the Cricket Tournament and Football Tournament for boys and girls of the locality. The indoor games also arranged for these participate. The trust spent amount Rs. 1150/- to for the activities.

n) **Annual Programme :-**

As per last year activities the trust during has organized cultural programme to promote cultural atmosphere in the society. The peoples are participation in these activities triggered up the all-round success of the trust. An amount Rs. 1162/- was spent for this purpose. The local people are very pleased about this programme.

o) **Glorious Day :-**

The trust has been organized Rabindra Jayanti, Independence Day and others Glorious day celebration with our local people. The executive committee has been sanctioned an amount of Rs. 325/- for this programme.
